



**IASAS Board Meeting Minutes**  
**Wednesday, November 9, 2016 at 6 am EST**

1. Meeting was called to order by Lisa at 6:10 am EST
2. September meeting minutes were approved and posted to the website.
3. Tadd updated the board on where we are in meeting our membership strategies by region. At our next meeting we will review our strategic plan and discuss further membership strategies.
4. Tadd updated on the board on what is happening with the two committee who are reviewing the constitution and elections process that will assist us in operating virtually.
5. Marketing has gone out about the Student Leader Global Summit and students can apply until December 10. If you would like to help with selecting students please let Lisa know. Decisions will be made around December 15. The dates of the summit are March 24-26, 2017 and it will be held in Columbus Ohio before the ACPA conference. Lead365 facilitators are leading this for free and food will be covered for the summit and students will stay in a residence hall together for \$24 a double per night. Thus, the main cost to the student is transportation. Please note only 24 students will be selected. The goal is to choose students from different regions of the world. When we held the first summit we had students from South Africa, Botswana, USA, Canada, Germany and Poland.
6. Howard updated the board on the IASAS special edition of the JSAA and they have six manuscripts they are reviewing. Birgit and Lisa are working on having someone completing a book review for this edition of the new IASAS/NASPA book. At this point they have enough reviewers.
7. Birgit announced that there were 52 participates from 19 different countries at the Global Summit in Cape Town South Africa. The Global Summit planning committee facilitated the program and went very well and it was a good partnership with NASPA. The University World News covered the summit and the result was that there were two articles in the last two issues respectively. Lisa congratulated Birgit on hosting a fantastic summit.
8. Eva-Marie provided a thorough report on the mentoring program and we will start the recruiting participants for the program. She will use the feedback she received to structure the program further. The mentor/mentee program will run from December 2016 to May 2017. Birgit and Eva-Marie will work on possibly publishing.

9. Qi shared his thoughts on developing a questionnaire of academic degrees on student affairs and services. We discussed it would be good to understand the curriculum of each program, the student population etc. This will help to understand what resources may be helpful to these programs.
10. IASAS will be presenting at ACPA and AIEA.
11. Vianna reported that she shared information about IASAS with the ASET (the UK Placement organization).
