- 1) Meeting was called to order at 8:10 am EST.

1. Over the summer I have hosted a NACA visit here in Sheffield and facilitated their meetings with AMOSSHE and NUS in London, all with opportunities to raise the profile of IASAS.
2. I hosted an IASAS meeting at the AMOSSHE national conference in July in UK.
3. I attended the NASPA Stevens Institute in California in July, and spoke with Kevin Kruger about opportunities for IASAS and NASPA to collaborate - this building on previous conversations with the IASAS President.
4. I spoke at a Leadership Foundation for HE Student Experience conference in London in July, and included promotional material about IASAS.
5. Since the last Board meeting I have been in touch with a number of colleagues in other European networks, to further promote membership of IASAS; there are now around 100 European members.
6. I am attending a HUMANE (European HE Management network) event in Oxford later in September. This will be attended by colleagues from around 15 different European countries and I shall be taking the opportunity to promote IASAS (note it is not a Student Affairs audience).

The Directors of student services of Australian universities recently held their annual meeting in Canberra. Fostering a greater connection of IASAS with the Australia and New Zealand Student Services Association (ANZSSA) was discussed, and formation of a council of student services organisations that could become a peak consultative body for the region regarding higher education and student affairs. ANZSSA/Australia has also submitted a bid to host the 2014 NASPA-IASAS Global Summit.

Richard Zereik from McGill University, Montreal, and I will be co-presenting at the ANZSSA conference in New Zealand in December. One of Richard's presentations being: "IASAS: A borderless global movement". We look forward to promoting and developing the work of IASAS in that international forum.
